

PRINCIPLES OF EFFECTIVE SUPERVISION

This two-day course will provide a foundation for the supervision and evaluation of Colorado teachers. Day one will have a focus on the theory and research behind effective leadership and instructional coaching. This will also include effective supervision instruction. It will meet “Requirement 1” for evaluators in the state of Colorado. Day two will meet “Requirement 2” by introducing the Educator Effectiveness system and tools.
